

## 09 “New” Referee Sign-up Procedures

- 1.) Using the link below, log onto Gotsoccer & create a referee acct. Be sure to use an email specific for the referee. Parents with multiple referees/children need to have a separate email address & can NOT use one email for each referee.

- 2.) Using the link below, log onto OSA soccer & sign up for a class that you prefer. Can be any 09 course anywhere in the state of Oklahoma. You will use the referee Gotsoccer user ID & password to register for the course. - 3.) Use the below instructions to complete the other requirements. Note: If the referee is under 18 years of age.... The background check is not required.

### NEW REFEREES MUST ATTEND AN 09 COURSE

1. Select an 09 course you wish to attend from the list above. Click on the registration link for that class and complete two forms: a registration form that informs the hosting club of your attendance; and a second form requiring you to pay the \$60 to attend the class. Both of these are required to be completed PRIOR to attending the class. The host club will NOT take cash at the site and time will not be given for registration during the class. If you do not have internet access you may visit a library or use your smart phone.
2. If you are 18 or older, a third form, a background check will be required. When following the registration for the class process, a form will appear but it is NOT the correct form. 3. Prior to attending the class all referee candidates must visit the USSF online 09 course and view the entire course. For the 09 course link, [click here](#). The 09 class is now two sessions of 3 hours each. Spanish 09 course, [click here](#)
4. Print off the required coursebook for the 09 class. [COURSEBOOK](#)
5. Once the class is successfully completed you will be given a 2014 09 referee badge UNLESS you have not met all the requirements above.

- 4.) Order referee uniform & equipment. There are a few websites you can use to order referee equipment provided below. Some have a package deal with flags, cards, flip coin, ect. Yellow shirts are the main color we use. Note: an additional color will be needed in case of a color conflict with one of the teams.
